



YMCA Camp McConnell Scholarship Information 2015

Description and Purpose

At Camp McConnell, we believe that all children should have the opportunity to attend camp, regardless of economic hardships. The Camp McConnell Scholarship Program aims to provide this opportunity to such children

Amount Available

Funding for scholarships comes primarily from private donations and is limited. Most assistance is in the form of partial scholarships. Full scholarships are rare and granted only in cases of extreme hardship. All scholarships are dependent upon a full summer camp enrollment, which in turn assures that the camp's basic financial obligations can be met. Typical scholarship awards are given at a 50% discount off of the base fee.

Criteria

The only criterion is financial need; however, all campers are expected to follow camp rules. Campers receiving scholarship that are unable to complete their camp sessions due to their inability to follow camp rules can expect to be denied future scholarship requests.

Deadline

Scholarships are awarded on April 14, 2015 and letters regarding scholarship awards will be mailed immediately thereafter. Please return your application prior to this date. Please do not call to check on the status of scholarship application before this date.

Applications Must Include

- A cover letter outlining your circumstances and giving any information you deem important and which applies to your scholarship application
- A completed scholarship application form.
- Required documentation
 - A copy of the most recent tax return for everyone living in the household or verification on non-requirement to file (phone number to the IRS: 1-800-829-1040)
 - The last two paycheck stubs of everyone in the household who is working
 - Letter from the Social Security Administration if applicable
 - Proof of any other source of income if applicable
